- ➤ Most Early Application deadlines have passed* (Early Decision and Early Action and out-of-state Public University Applications)
 - ➤ USF (74 complete/27 pending). Early application release date 12/12. Rolling thereafter
 - > FSU (106 complete/5 pending). Early application release date 12/15
 - \triangleright UF (134 complete and pending). Admissions decisions notification 2/24/2023
 - ➤ UCF (72 complete/17 pending/40 admitted ths far). Rolling release
- Upcoming application deadlines
 - > Florida State University Regular Deadline 12/1
 - Upcoming Regular Decision applications January 2 (and EDII deadlines)
 - Private and public Rolling Application deadlines ongoing

Florida Bright Futures Scholarship Program

The Florida Bright Futures Scholarship Program rewards students for their academic achievements by providing funding to attend postsecondary institutions in Florida

- > There are three award levels
 - ➤ Florida Academic Scholar (FAS)
 - > Florida Medallion Scholar (FMS)
 - Gold Seal Vocational Scholar (GSV)
- ➤ There are Grade Point Average, Test Score and Community Service/Work requirements for each level

Bright Futures Award Amounts (2022-23)

- Florida Academic Scholars (FAS) will receive 100% of tuition and applicable fees
- Florida Medallion Scholars (FMS) will receive 75% of tuition and applicable fees
 - Bright Futures is only available at Florida colleges/universities
 - Students attending private, in-state institutions receive a sum equivalent to the public university reimbursement
 - Bright Futures can be used in Summer term



How/When Do I Apply for Bright Futures?

- The Bright Future Application opened October 1, 2022
- Instructions for completing the Bright Futures application were sent home via email. Instructions are uploaded to the PVS college counseling website under *Announcements* and *Resources*. Please apply now!
- We ask <u>ALL</u> seniors to make an initial application regardless of whether they intend to apply in-state

The Bright Futures Scholarship ACT, SAT, PERT extended testing deadline for 2020-21 high school graduates expired on December 1, 2021. No additional extensions have been granted. At this time, there is <u>not</u> an Emergency Order in place to grant a testing deadline extension for 2021-22 high school graduates.



First-Time Applicants

Students must submit a completed Florida Financial Aid Application (FFAA) to OSFA for programs denoted by an asterisk (*). In order to apply for State Scholarship & Grant Programs, a student must first Create a Student Account.

After logging into your account, you may proceed to complete the FFAA.

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Bright Futures Eligibility Evaluations

- Early 7th semester evaluations will post late January. To be eligible for Summer 2023 reimbursement students must meet initial eligibility requirements (GPA, Scores, and Hours). Final 8th semester evaluations post in July
- Students must monitor award status online. After submitting the FFAA, the student is responsible for tracking application and award status online (Students must update college selection in the Spring)



Florida PrePaid College Plans

- > Tuition plan covers the basic cost of classes
- ➤ Local fee plan covers the state required fees
- > Dormitory plan covers the cost of a standard, double-occupancy room at a Florida university
- ➤ Specific questions regarding your plan should be directed to the Florida PrePaid program http://www.myfloridaprepaid.com/



Florida Pre-Paid & Florida Bright Futures FAQs

- ➤ Pre-Paid Tuition Plan may *not* cover all costs. In the case of the Tuition Plan, funds are applied to the student's tuition charges only
- Typically Pre-Pay is applied first. Bright Futures funds are applied to remaining charges *after* classes begin (there is some variation in this)*
- Excess funds remaining after tuition is paid will be applied to other charges owed to the school, including on-campus housing costs, etc
- Florida Prepaid plan holders can request to defer the use of their Prepaid Plan and use Bright Futures first if they so choose
- ➤ Each college is slightly different. Be sure to check with the college(s) you are considering attending



Financial Aid and Scholarships

- Once again, FAFSA completion is required for all *need-based* and *need-informed* scholarships. It is may also be expected for *merit-based* aid as well
- In addition to institutional aid and scholarships which you may receive with your acceptance and that are listed in your financial aid 'award letter,' there are numerous private and corporate-sponsored *application-based* scholarships opportunities available.


